Report of Webinar

College, Jaipur said that the New Education Policy told about the qualitative parameters in teacher education programme to make the pre service teacher more competent in global scenario. In present internship process in Rajasthan the students are not getting in touch and direct monitoring of Teacher Educators so the development of professional competencies of pupil teachers can't identified and improve properly without direct observation & also evaluation of pupil teachers during internship by teacher educators.

Dr. Anil Kumar Srivastava Principal, As Chair of webinar concluded the theme and said a large number of initiatives are introduced in New Education Policy in context of Teacher Education those are giving hope that sweet dream of qualitative Teacher Education of India is going to become true. They also raid very practical issue that the salary of private institution teachers should be increased to bring education up to a higher level so that they can be encouraged to do excellent work.
